1. Siete Soles Semillon / Chardonnay 2007 - Central Valley Chile £ 13.85
Fresh and well-balanced, with notes of melon, peach and grapefruit, and a ripe generosity on the palate.
2. Le Bouquet de Georges Duboeuf Blanc Vin de Table Francaise £ 13.85
Fresh floral aroma and crisp ripe fruit on the palate. A dry, easy-drinking style.
3. Trebbiano del Rubicone Soledoro 2007 - Italy £ 13.85
Crisp refreshing white with a citrus lemon fruit and light appley bite

France

4. Sauvignon Blanc Domaine de la Prade 2006 £ 15.50
Vin de Pays des Cotes de Thongue. France
A fresh, well rounded wine with lovely gooseberry flavours and a clean dry finish.
5. Chablis 1er Cru Fourchaume 2006 - Jean-Marc Brocard £ 29.50
Medium bodied with a core of apple, pear and flinty fruit. Long and intense finish.
6. Petit Chablis 2006 - Thierry Hamelin £ 23.50
A ripe Chablis with good weight and intensity. Green apple and pear emerges on the finish.
7. Sancerre les Boffants 2006 - Charles Dupuy. Loire £ 26.00
Herbaceous, grassy Sauvignon fruit with lovely gooseberry flavours.
8. Macon-Charnay Georges Duboeuf 2006 £ 19.75
Crisp, appley un-oaked burgundy, with a nicely rounded mid-palate, some buttery nutty notes, and an even, mineral finish.

Rest of Europe

9. Mannara Pinot Grigio Grillo 2006 - Sicilia IGT £ 15.50
Fresh crisp fruit with a slight hint of smokiness and a long fruity palate
10. Pinot Grigio Mezzacorona 2006 - Trentino. Italy £ 19.85
Dry with fragrant floral notes, good ripe sleek fruit and a long spicy aromatic finish.
11. Tormaresca Chardonnay Puglia IGT 2006 - Antinori, Italy £ 18.50
Bright, fruity medium bodied Chardonnay showing the purity and richness of Puglian fruit.
12. Finca Antigua Blanco Viura 2006 - Spain £ 17.50
A complex un-oaked Viura, showing aromas of pear, apricot and fennel, a balanced, energetic palate, and a long, fruity finish.
13. Colbaraca Soave Classico 2006 - Masi Veneto, Italy £ 19.95
A rich and complex wine with intense tropical fruits, but still retaining the bitter almond flavour of a classic Soave.

New World

14. Santa Rita Grand Hacienda Sauvignon Blanc 2006/07 - Lontue Valley, Chile £ 16.25
Dry with rich tropical fruit flavours and a citrus finish. Chilean wine at its best.
15. Pewsey Vale Riesling 2007 - Eden Valley, Australia £ 19.95
This classic dry Riesling is a rich and intensely flavoured wine. Pale straw in colour with green hues it has bright fruit aromas of limes and lemons, with a hint of overlaying dried herb and hint of tropical fruit.
16. Bulletin Place Chardonnay 2006/07 - Evans, South Australia £ 18.95
A lovely wine with tropical fruit flavours of peach and pineapple. Buttery with a soft finish.
17. Coopers Creek Sauvignon Blanc 2007 - Marlborough, New Zealand £ 18.95
This is absolutely classic Marlborough Sauvignon: vibrant passion fruit, gooseberry and tomato leaf aromas; good breadth on the palate; crisp, refreshing balance; lovely length of flavour.
18. Y-Series Viognier Yalumba 2006 - Australia £ 18.95
The aroma is intense with white flowers – particularly honeysuckle – and hints of apricot nectar. The palate is rich and long, with citrus and tropical fruit flavours. This wine exhibits the typical Viognier texture silky, rich and luscious with a lovely fresh finish.
19. Kanu Chenin Blanc 2006/07 - Stellenbosch. South Africa £ 15.95
A great wine, big and soft with layers of ripe fruit flavours.

Champagne and Sparkling

20. Champagne Testulat. Blanc De Noir NV - France £ 32.00
A very elegant house Champagne made from Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier. Dry, rich and fruity with a delicate mousse.
21. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label - France £ 49.00
Elegant and biscuity. A great Champagne
22. Champagne Moet Et Chandon Brut NV - France £ 46.00
Needs no introduction.
23. Rene Barbier Cava Rosado Brut NV Spain £ 17.25
Vibrant in colour and aroma, full of raspberry and redcurrant fruit, delicate bubbles and an attractive dry finish.
24. Jansz Tasmanian Premium Cuvee NV £ 17.85
The bouquet shows lifted aromas of honeysuckle and citrus fruits from the Chardonnay, with nougat and roasted nuts derived from the tirage age, while the Pinot Noir contributes delicate strawberry. The palate is well balanced with delicate

25. Siete Soles Cabernet /Merlot Central Valley Chile 2007 £ 13.85
Ripe red fruit aromas with notes of blackberries, blueberries and black pepper. Medium bodied and well-balanced.

26. Le Bouquet de Georges Duboeuf Rouge Vin de Table Francaise £ 13.85
Vibrant berry and spice aromas; smooth in the mouth with cherry and raspberry flavours

27. Sangiovese del Rubicone Soledoro 2007 - Italy £ 13.85
Ripe cherry and plum flavours make this wine soft, smooth and easy drinking

France

28. Domaine La Prade Merlot Languedoc-Roussillon 2006 £ 15.50
A smooth, spicy Merlot with aromas of plums, berries and tobacco. The palate is medium-full and packed with fruit and savoury flavours.

29. Fleurie Clos de Quatre Vents 2006 - Beaujolais £ 25.50
A top Cru Beaujolais, unique for its floral aromas of irises, roses and violets. Velvety and smooth with peach and blackcurrant flavours.

30. Bourgogne Pinot Noir Alain Michelot 2005 - Burgundy £ 26.50
A Bourgogne rouge of unusual depth and intensity, with perfumed blackberry/black cherry fruit.

31. Chateauneuf-du-Pape Haute Pierre 2005 - Delas Freres. Rhone £ 34.00
Juicy sweet, ripe fruits with an impressive backbone of ripe tannins. Delicious.

Rest of Europe

32. Santa Cristina Chianti Superiore Antinori 2006 - Italy £ 19.95
Red berry fruit on the nose with floral hints of violets and spicy sensations from the oak barrels. A well structured wine, velvety on the palate with floral hints and fresh red berry fruit in the finish.

33. Sabazio Rosso di Montepulciano 2005/06 - La Braccasca. Italy £ 19.50
Intense black fruit flavours, ripe and full with smooth rounded tannins.

34. Conde De Valdemar Rioja Reserva 2002 - Martinez Bujanda. Spain £ 22.50
Big fruity wine with soft vanilla oak and a rich silky finish

New World

35. Santa Rita Gran Hacienda Merlot 2004/05 - Rapel Valley. Chile £ 17.25
Soft and velvety with intense aromas of ripe red fruits.

36. Organic McLarenVale Shiraz 2005 - Yalumba, Australia £ 19.95
The wine is deep purple in colour and shows a complex rich, ripe black fruit nose. The palate is dense but soft with dark fruits, lots of weight and texture and lingering sweet oak flavours.

37. Stimsons Estate Merlot 2005 - Washington State, USA £ 17.95
Medium bodied, fruit driven style of Merlot, with notes of cherries, plums and tobacco. Soft and smooth in the mouth with an appealing rounded finish.

38. Whistling Duck Cabernet / Shiraz 2005 - South Australia £ 18.75
Smooth and full-bodied with lovely berry flavours and a soft spicy finish.

39. Coopers Creek Pinot Noir 2006 - Marlborough, New Zealand £ 21.50
A classic New Zealand style of Pinot, with bright, pure brambly fruit aromas, cherries and plums on the palate, and a fresh, vibrant structure

40. Malbec Finca La Colonia 2007 - Mendoza. Argentina £ 16.85
Dark, concentrated and intensely rich. A great wine

41. Passo Doble 2006 - Masi. Tupungato. Argentina £ 19.95
Deep ruby colour with flavours of sweet cherry and plum, hint of cocoa and a long smooth finish.

42. Pinotage Ruitersvlei 2006 - Paarl. South Africa £ 17.50
South Africa's own grape variety producing a sumptuous spicy wine.

43. Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva 2005 - Maipo Valley. Chile £ 18.25
Smooth with well integrated oak, exhibiting ripe plum and blackcurrant flavours.

44. Yalumba Y Series Shiraz 2006 - Australia £ 18.65
Soft and elegant with red berries and spicy flavours.

45. Sebastiani Zinfandel 2005 - USA £ 18.95
Very smooth and juicy, with ripe black fruit and no hard edges – a gentle giant.

Rosé

46. Cabernet Sauvignon Rose 2006/07 - Santa Rita. Chile £ 17.50
Made from 100% Cabernet Sauvignon, a big wine with superb flavours of Raspberry and strawberry.

47. Stone Cellars Zinfandel Blush 2006 - Beringer, California £ 18.25
The most famous blush on the market. Off dry, with lovely red berry flavours.

Dessert

48. Muscat de Frontignan 2005/06 - Chateau de Stony. France 1/2bot £ 14.65
A honied and luscious wine from the Languedoc Roussillon.

49. Yalumba Museum Release Muscat NV - Australia. 1/2bot £ 15.95
A luscious wine, deep tawny in colour, it has rose petal floral and rind characters.
